**POSITION SUMMARY:**

The candidate will have the opportunity to work on a Kaiser Permanente Division of Research epidemiologic study funded by the National Cancer Institute. The study will examine how lifestyle

and molecular factors affect breast cancer prognosis. We plan to examine whether factors such as dietary habits, physical activity, quality of life, and use of complementary and alternative therapies influence recurrence rates or mortality from breast cancer. Research is conducted among the Northern California Kaiser Permanente health plan (3.2 million members). Blood specimens will be collected to examine genetic factors that might influence breast cancer treatment and prognosis.

#### QUALIFICATIONS:

Must have at least two years experience working in a health care or research setting.

Proven ability to do venipuncture on female adults of all ages (mean age of participants in study is 60 years).

Must be dependable, punctual, and able to follow detailed protocols precisely.

Must be cooperative with co-workers and supervisors.

Travel is required. Ability to use own car, valid California driver's license and auto insurance is needed (mileage reimbursed).
